We operate a paperless booking system with all communication and payment made online.

We are committed to reducing our energy consumption by:

- Replacing light bulbs with energy efficient bulbs where possible
- Turning down wall heaters during the day when the chalet tends to be empty
- Ensuring electrical appliances are unplugged and not left on standby when not in use
- Turning lights off when rooms are vacated

We recycle our old linen and staff clothing through donation to charitable causes (2010 donation made to Red Cross).
