We are looking for a highly organised, friendly and enthusiastic person with a passion for cooking, good cookery skills and some experience in the hospitality industry to join us for the season 2017-18 to run Chalet Les Cabris, an 8 bed catered chalet, from December to April.

Duties include:

- Greeting guests and acting as a point of contact for all preliminary requirements such as ski hire, lessons, childcare etc when guests arrive in resort. These services will generally have already been pre-booked through Alpine Ethos
- Maintaining a relationship with the guests throughout their stay, ensuring that any questions and/or requirements are met
- Fostering a friendly, relaxed atmosphere in the chalet at all times
- Preparing and cooking one hot breakfast option each day (apart from one day off per week), setting the breakfast table with continental items and serving the hot breakfast
- Daily room and chalet cleaning after breakfast service
- Baking afternoon tea cake and laying out afternoon tea
- Preparing and cooking a 3 course meal for 8 guests on 6 evenings, setting the dinner table, serving dinner and clearing down
- Chalet changeover on Saturdays (cleaning & bed making)
- Food shopping once per week
- Helping keep the chalet exterior tidy and free from snow on main walkways

The ideal candidate will have:

- Confidence in the kitchen, with the ability to work efficiently to produce delicious “home cooked” food
- Strong work ethic and ability to work in a team
- Friendly front of house persona
- Stamina and consistency
